

Driver - Installer

Job Description

Major Responsibility

Safely drive crew(s) to each work site and back to the warehouse daily and assist crew with stocking each job upon arrival. The driver is to safely operate the vehicle and use independent judgment in handling all driving situations. The driver is to request the passenger(s) to help direct if they see an unsafe situation, i.e. backing up, directing around close corners, blind spots, etc. Begin training on proper installation of all applications of insulation.

Qualifications needed

Current valid DL

Must sustain a good MVR (driving record)

Must be at least 18 years of age

Team Player – willing contributor to team and assigned crew

Positive Attitude

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

Working knowledge of the rules and regulations of safe and efficient driving

The ability to operate a box truck, van, etc.

Ability to follow oral and written instructions

Job duties

Perform pre trip or post trip daily inspection of vehicle you are operating

Safely load and unload material from the truck as needed

The driver is to assist the crew in stocking the house and spreading the material throughout the job.

The driver is to work alongside the crew and do the necessary cleanup while the crew is working, i.e., picking up and bundling trash to bring back to the warehouse for disposal, sweeping the house upon completion.

Along with crew, bundle empty bags to bring back to the warehouse for install verification with the warehouse.

The driver is to check with the superintendents to see if he/she is needed to do any additional material deliveries, throughout the day.

The driver is to train on the install of all applications of insulation: Polyseal, batts, cellulose, attic blow, etc. Once driver has been appropriately trained, they will switch from hourly to piece rate pay and be expected to assist in the install of material at a job.

The driver will get instructions from the Field Superintendents and Production Supervisor. The driver will be expected to cooperate and work productively with the production team, crew members, mechanic and warehouse staff.

The above statements are intended to describe the general nature and level of work being performed and are not an exhaustive list of all duties and responsibilities. Duties and responsibilities may change to meet the needs of Garland Insulating and its customer base.
